### Outline

*The aim of this course is to refresh the work at heights unit standards currently held to ensure that they are kept up to date with current legislation and to inform students of any changes in best practice techniques or equipment. The course also has a practical component to ensure students are correctly and safely using the equipment required to carry out a working at height task.*
