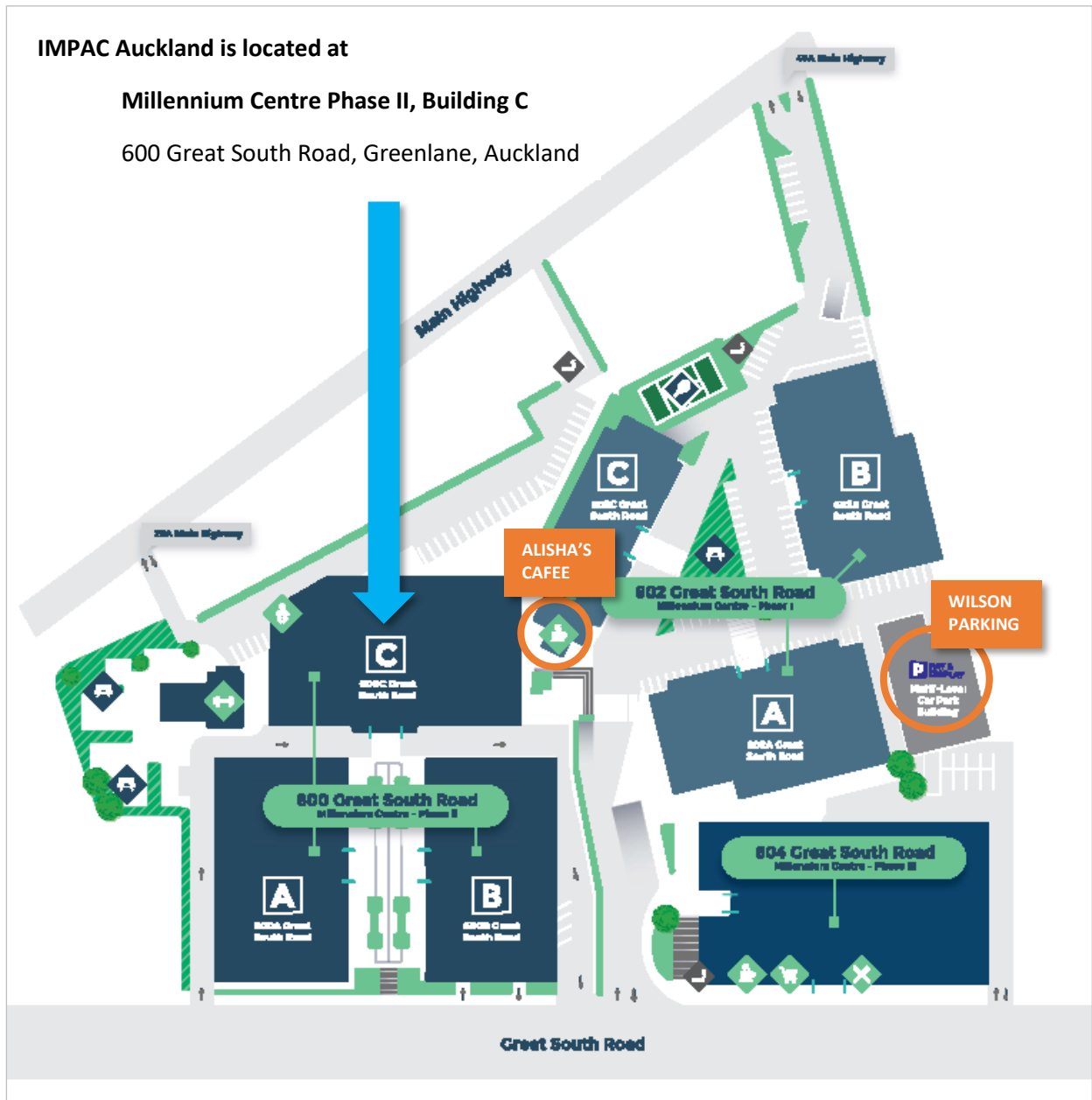


LOCATION

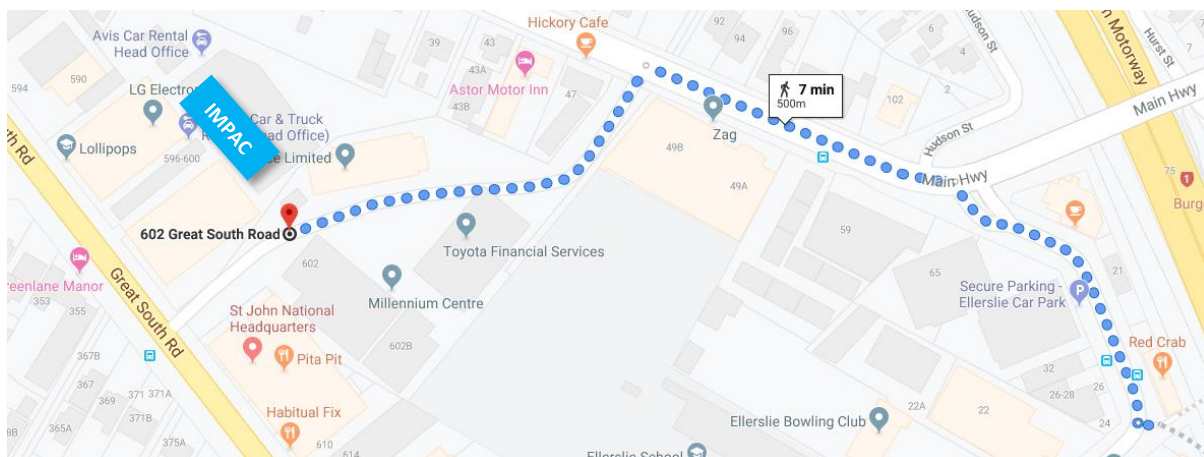
GETTING THERE



BY TRAIN

Millennium Centre is located close to the ELLERSLIE train station, which serves both the Southern and Onehunga lines.

From the Ellerslie station, it is a 5 minute walk to Millennium Centre.



BY BUS

You can access Millennium Centre on Great South Road via multiple bus routes.

BY CAR

From SH1, take the **Ellerslie/Penrose exit** to Millennium Centre, 600 Great South Road.

Wilson Carparking is available both within the Millennium Centre and adjacent at Central Park, 666 Great South Road.

Wilson Parking at Millennium Centre, 602 Great South Road
26 casual parks available. \$15/day.

Wilson Carpark at 666 Great South Road, Central Building
205 casual car park spaces available. \$16/day.

Please ensure you park in a casual (not reserved) carpark only. Prices are correct at Sept 2019, but subject to change.

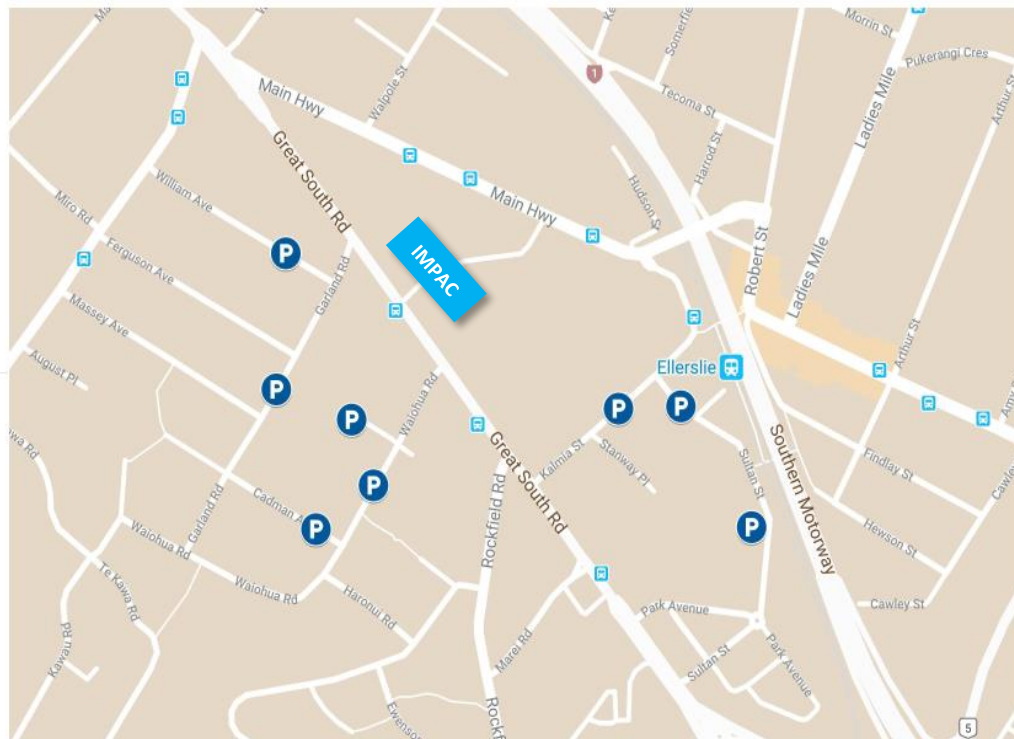

This map is indicative of street parking options surrounding the Millenium Center. Please observe the specific parking signs per street to ensure you park on the correct side of the road where there are no time restrictions.



DISABLED VISITOR CARPARKS

Disabled Visitor Parking is located directly outside Building C front door (two parks) – these are accessed from Great South Road, through the very first driveway (when coming from Newmarket) which runs onto the podium at the front of Building C.

There are two more disabled carparks within Building C basement. These basement parks can be freely accessed (no swipe card needed for the barrier arm before 10:00am) and lift access can be freely accessed before 10:00am also.

After 10:00am a swipe card is needed for the barrier arm and lifts.

Visitors using disabled parks must display a disabled badge.

All disabled parks are on a 1st come 1st served basis.

WILSON CARPARK

The Wilson carpark is located by **Phase I Building A**.

You can enter and exit from either:

- Great South Road – main Millennium entrance
- Main Highway Ellerslie – main Phase I entrance

There is allocated and public parking within this building.

You need to pay by number plate in a public parking space.

RESERVED CLIENT CARPARK

The exterior carparks are accessed from Main Highway Ellerslie.

There is a driveway directly opposite St Mary's Catholic School.

Drive down this driveway and as you veer left, you will see the IMPAC visitor carpark #29.

Building C is directly adjacent to this carpark.
